

## IntraLAN's *Business Continuum* pre-requisites

The following 6 simple prerequisites are required to deliver the *Business Continuum* service:



### 1. LDM location

Identify a discreet location for the LDM that has power and CAT5 port. It needs unhindered airflow from its sides (it runs very quietly) and is W43 x 9H x 39D cm (size of small desktop PC), preferably placed flat;

### 2. Internet line

Internet line that is either: aDSL (minimum 20:1, ½Mb), sDSL, leased or other permanent Internet connection (min. 250K outbound). Ensure you have not subscribed to an ISP service with limitations in data quantity (we don't).

### 3. Security

Open port 4744 on your firewall(s). This is an *outbound only* port and has been specifically registered for Business Continuum with IANA (see <http://www.iana.org/assignments/port-numbers> ) in order to allow data synchronisation with the data vaults.

### 4. Exchange defrag

As part of good housekeeping and to minimise any subsequent large changes, we recommend that you undertake a standard off-line Exchange defrag. Contact us if you would like help.

### 5. PC applications

We need the *original install disks* for all your PC applications. We will install them (for you to evaluate data in Test Restores) and copy an image (for Terminal Services and PC rebuilds in event of a Office loss).

### 6. Management PCs

Identify which PCs you would like the BC Manager application loaded.
